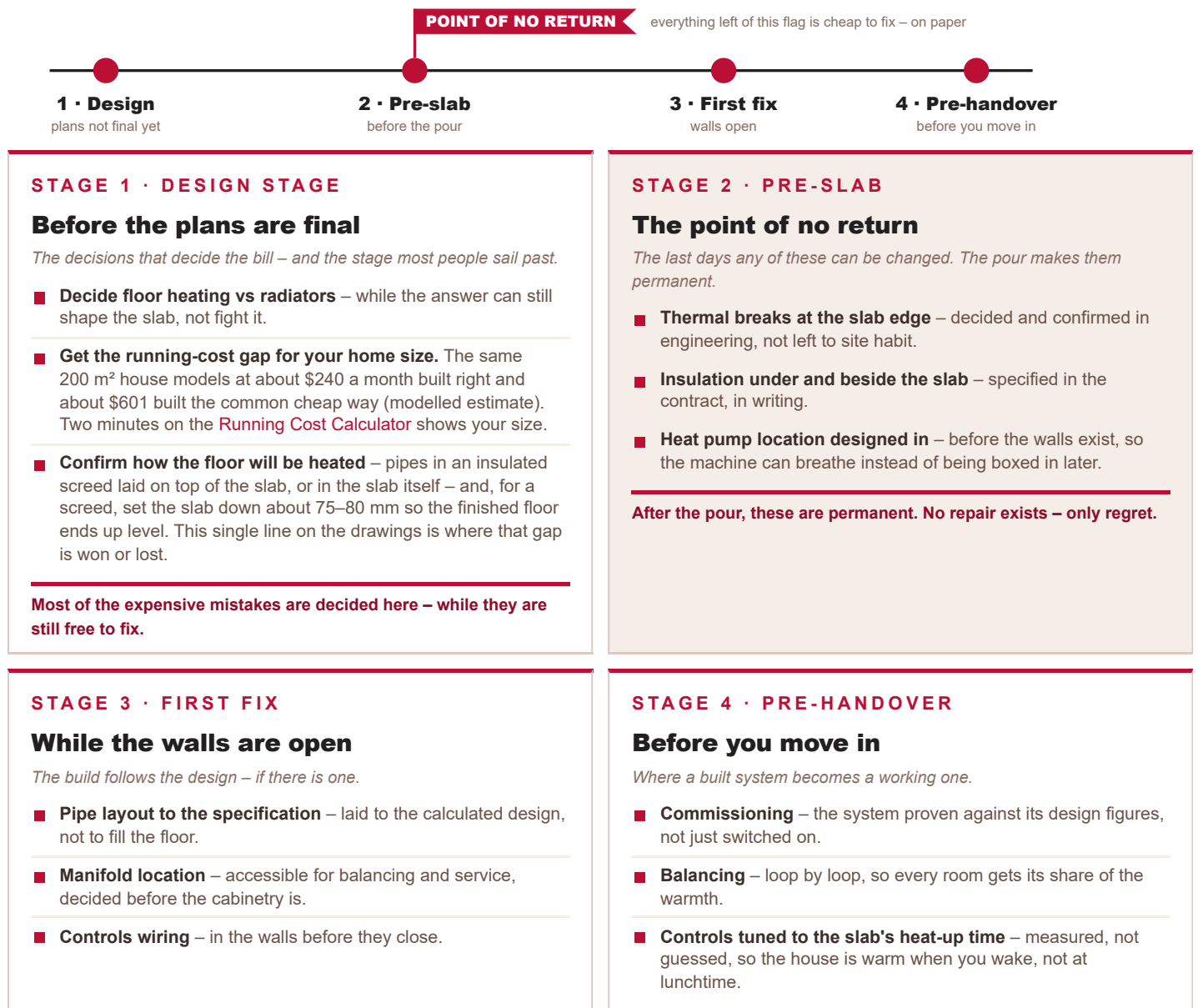


Building in the Next Year or Two? The Heating Decisions You Have to Lock In – and Exactly When.
